SERVING AT RMCC

Ephesians 4:15b,16 “The head is Christ from whom the whole body, joined and knit together by what every joint supplies, according to the effective working by which every part does it’s share, causes growth of the body for the edifying of itself in love.”

RMCC is a family that thrives when we serve one another in love **Galatians 5:13**.

Jesus has given each one of us gifts that are intended to be shared with His Body and when we serve in the power of the Holy Spirit the work bears good fruit in the life of the servant and in the greater body. **Ephesians 2:10** “For we are His workmanship created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them.”

There are three basic guidelines in order to serve at RMCC:

Present yourself to God.

We are to present ourselves as living sacrifices, holy and acceptable to God (Romans 12:1). Because our service is unto the Lord, it is vital our lives reflect His lordship and direction. Therefore, people serving must not practice willful or unrepentant sin. This doesn’t mean we expect perfection, but a life that reflects God’s ongoing work of conforming you in the image of Christ.

Study to show yourself approved to God.

2 Timothy 2:15 tells us that an approved servant is one who is able to rightly divide the truth. You are called to be a student of the Word! There is a commitment to personal devotion and sitting under the teaching of our senior pastor.

Commit yourself to the work of Jesus.

Our service should be a work of faith, a labor of love and with steadfastness in the hope of Jesus (1 Thessalonians 1:3). The catalyst for our service is the love of Jesus and the furtherance of the Gospel. Ministry should never be done for applause or selfish gain.

After an initial 6 month period of “Sit & Soak”, where the individual gets to know us and we them, there are numerous opportunities to serve at RMCC.
